With the following data protection information, we, **Julius Schulte Trebsen GmbH & Co.KG**, Pauschwitz Str. 45, 04687 Trebsen, Germany, as controller within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), explain which personal data we process when you visit our website. We would like to point out that all data transfers carried out in connection with our website take place via an encrypted SSL connection.

We reserve the right to amend our data protection information as and when necessary so as to ensure it always meets current legal requirements or in order to reflect changes to our services. We therefore recommend that you read this data protection information regularly, in order to stay up to date with how we are protecting the personal data we process.

Logging and creating log files

When you visit www.schulte-trebsen.de, a range of technical data are logged. These general data and information are saved in the log files of the server. Your IP address, your browser ID and name, the name of the file retrieved, the date and time of retrieval, the quantity of data transferred and the successful retrieval are recorded in a log file. Personal data are processed, on the basis of a legitimate interest in accordance with Article 6(1)(f) GDPR, for the provision of the website as well as for troubleshooting and for the investigation of abusive or fraudulent behaviour. Log files are deleted after 7 days.

Use of service providers for website provision

In order to provide the website, we make use of service providers who process personal data on behalf of Julius Schulte Trebsen GmbH or whose access to personal data cannot be excluded. We have concluded contracts for contractual processing in accordance with Article 28 GDPR with these service providers.
